# Indiana Higher Education Telecommunication System



*A consortium of Indiana's public and independent colleges and universities*



These utilization statistics for technology and e-learning services are for FY 2005–06 (July 1 to June 30) except where noted.

**Network connectivity support** was provided to six public and 27 independent higher education institutions.

Five public and 27 independent institutions took advantage of IHETS' **Internet2 sponsorship**.

**Technology training** was provided to 217 individuals during 39 sessions. Online training materials were downloaded 12,300 times.

## 2005–06 service metrics

- **Video conferencing and bridging**

Between August 2005 and August 2006, consortium members and affiliates utilized a total of **35,771 hours** of video conferencing.

- **Audio conferencing and bridging**

Audio conferencing services provided to members and affiliates from August 2005 to August 2006 totalled **60,996 minutes**.

- **Web conferencing (IHETS Interactive)**

Launched July 1, 2006, there were a total of **3,902 scheduled hours** through December accessed by 1,900 consortium faculty, staff, and students (these numbers reflect a partial academic year).

- **Audio and video streaming**

The number of Web visits to live and archived audio and video content streamed by IHETS was **832,606**.

- **SUVON (State Universities Voice Network)**

This network connecting 77 campuses, reaches 80 percent of Indiana calling areas and included **4,784,156 minutes** between August 2005 and August 2006.

- **Online course schedule/inventory by semester**

This inventory included **212 degree and certificate programs** and **3,224 class offerings**, generating a total of **268,540 searches** in 2005–06.

- **Inter-institutional student registration**

IHETS processed 4,328 cross-registrations processed in 2005–06, serving 3,753 students registering for 4,055 consortium courses at institutions other than their “home” campus.

- **Professional development activities**

There were a total of 13 events coordinated by IHETS to assist consortium faculty and staff strengthen their use of information and instructional technologies. These events reached 3,492 participants who gave than an average top rating of 89 percent.
